#### SPECIAL DEMONSTRATION AND TRAINING SESSION

#### PEDESTRIAN INFRASTRUCTURE ASSESSMENT TOOL DEMONSTRATION (90 MIN)

BMC, working with the consultant Toole Design, developed a Pedestrian Infrastructure Assessment Tool for the BMC region. The ArcGIS-based desktop tool will assist local planners in prioritizing sidewalk projects, identifying sidewalk mileage and gaps, visualizing sidewalk data and facilitating pedestrian planning in general.

A demonstration of the Pedestrian Infrastructure Assessment Tool will be given at the end of this meeting starting at 1:30 P.M. A question and answer session will then occur. The hour long demonstration session and Q&A is especially relevant for planners and GIS staff who work with pedestrian data.
