The Maryland Transportation Authority will discuss the launch of the Tier 2 NEPA Study following completion of the Tier 1 Study, and continues efforts to provide congestion relief at the William Preston Lane Jr. Memorial (Bay) Bridge and its approach highways from the Severn River Bridge to the US 50/301 split.
