3. CONNECTED VEHICLE APPLICATIONS WITHIN THE US 1 CORRIDOR (20 min.)

4. INRIX SIGNAL ANALYTICS (20 min.)

INRIX Signal Analytics is a cloud-based analytics application that uses crowd sourced vehicle waypoint data to help transportation professionals assess and improve their signalized intersection performance. The application summarizes individual vehicle statistics without the need for permanent vehicle detection infrastructure. Ms. Amy Lopez, Director Public Services, and her team will provide an overview.
