1. TIM TRAINING UPDATE

Pat Rooney provided an update on TIM training in Maryland. So far, 35.1% of responders have been trained. Pat is working on creating a virtual 4-hour course.

Pat prepared a 1-hour refresher to highlight areas where responders have shown to have gotten lax. This was given to over 100 responders in 13 sessions during fire safety stand down week in June. The 1-hour refresher video is available to those who are interested.

The group conducted the FHWA TIM self-assessment. The 2020 self-assessment form has been revised, about 14 questions have been removed. The group discussed the questions and identified strengths and areas needing improvement.
