33rd St. & Alameda, Baltimore Naro: 15, 1913

At Mr. Maching's request I went to Baltimore to decide on profile of 33rd 3t. as it passes through Venable Tark and its junction with road through park. Also cross section for 33rd St. and Alumeda and the connection of the latter with Clifton Vark, a change being needed at that point on account of a slight shift in alignment east of Marford Road. The section we had proposed for 33rd St.-(see general plan) had been found impracticable on account of the attitude of abutters who claimed the right to out through the wide space ' the between road and building line with private roads or paths as they had a mind (The abutters just west of Charles St. having h been upheld in this by the Street Opening Commission) so Mr. Manning and Mr. Williams said they was practically drivin to a two road section with a central planting space and I decided on a section as follows:



I made a sketch for connections at Vemable Park and Clifton Park; also a cross section in the former at summit of road where the cut is the deepest. Later went with Mr. Manning to Mr. Williams' office and got him to approve all I had tone. Said we ought the make a grading plan for road through Venable Park and Gross was asked to furnish us with the necessary data.
