Trail Counter Agreement

- Awarded a 41,000 grant to Baltimore City to purchase and install 4 multi-counter automated pedestrian and bicycle counters.
- RTC is providing the trail counters for the City to continue monitoring pedestrian and bicycle traffic along sections of open trail within the network.
- Trail Counters has been purchased and Installation should start soon.



Jones Falls Trail: Switch Backs

• The Jones Falls trail is a 10 mile hiking and bicycling trail that runs mostly along the length of its namesake The Jones Falls, a major north-south stream in and north of the city that has long acted as a major transportation corridor for the city.

• The Gwynns Falls Trail generally follows the creek to the Middle Branch the Patapsco River.

Herring Run Park Trail: Bel Air Rd Crossing

• The Park serves as urban oasis to many neighborhoods within proximity to Lake Montebello, Morgan State University, and Clifton Park.

• A trail currently extends from the Halls Spring Area (Harford Rd & Argonne Dr.) to Sinclair Lane, providing opportunities to walk or bike along the stream bed. A full loop extends from Harford to Belair Road and the trail runs along the South side of the stream from Belair Road to Sinclair Lane
