> prepare > assess > use good judgment > stay vigilant

IF THERE IS NOT AN IMMEDIATE EMERGENCYDo everything you can to get your vehicle off the highway

IF YOU ARE ABLE TO REMAIN IN YOUR VEHICLE

> Remain buckled and facing forward

IF YOU ARE UNABLE TO REMAIN IN YOUR VEHICLE

- > Do not stand near the vehicle
- > Move to higher ground, or behind a guardrail/embankment

If you need help, contact roadside assistance. If you're on an interstate call #77 or 9-1-1 if it is an emergency and wait until help arrives.
