Reduce Fatalities and Serious Injuries by Half by 2030.

Performance Objectives:

Fatalities: 391 by 2020 // 296 by 2030

Serious/Incapacitating Injuries: 2939 by 2020 // 2272 by 2030

Maryland's SHSP

- Establish Visionary/Aspirational Goals
 - Main Goal Statements: Reduce Fatalities & Serious Injuries
- Sub-Goals or Objectives:
 > 5-yr rolling averages of the '*Federal-5*'
- >ALL Metropolitan Planning Organizations (two options):
 - Support State SHSP Goals or
 - Establish Similar Goals for MPO defined areas

Baltimore Metropolitan Planning Organization Target Methodology: Fatalities

Toward Zero Deaths (TZD)

- Fixed end point
- (1/2 of 2008 numbers by 2030)
- Exponential trend line

Interim yearly targets (state / region)

- **2016** 442 / **188**
- **2017** 429 / **182**
- **2018** 416 / **176**
- **2019** 403 / **171**
- **2020** 391 / **166**
