

Self Certification of the Regional Transportation Planning Process

Why Self Certification?

The Metropolitan Planning Rule directs all Transportation Management Areas, meaning urbanized areas with a population of 200,000 or more, concurrent with the submittal of the proposed Transportation Improvement Program to the FHWA and the FTA, to certify that the metropolitan transportation planning process is being carried out by the State and the MPO in accordance with all applicable requirements.



What Are Those Applicable Requirements?

- 3. Nondiscrimination-Civil Rights (Civil Rights Act of 1964)
