# **Red Line Internship Program**

- Relaunched Red Line High School Internship Program this summer
- Six-week program for Edmondson High School students
  - First-day orientation took place on June 25 and program will run through early August
- Participants will learn about transportation investments, project development, transit operations, and community engagement







# **Purple Line Event**

- Unveiled first Purple Line light rail • vehicles on July 11
- Vehicles are 142 feet long
  - Longest in US
- Seats 80 passengers and can hold • up to 400 people







#### **Recent Grant Awards**

- ~\$4.7 million RAISE grant for Reisterstown Plaza TOD
  - Preliminary design and environmental work for transit-oriented development at Reisterstown Plaza Metro station
  - Study also will include Complete Streets and accessibility improvements
- \$25.4 million LowNo grant for battery-electric buses in Prince George's County
- \$960,000 Buses and Bus Facilities grant for new buses in Howard County









With \$960K, lawmakers commit to better connect Howard County transit to Baltimore area

## **Service Updates**

- Ridership highs in May
  - Over 6 million rides for first time since 2019
  - Post-COVID highs for Core Bus, Metro, and Mobility
- Notable reductions in Core Bus service cuts
  - In June, there were 6 days below 2%
  - Reached <0.5% cuts</li>
- New Commuter Bus schedules went into effect July 1
