

Annual Reporting for Baltimore Region Transit System – Statutory Requirements and Documentation

Commission's Annual Report

The Baltimore Regional Transit Commission is required to provide an annual report on the Baltimore region transit systems. This report includes key findings and recommendations to improve public transportation in the area.

Code of Maryland Regulations, Transportation Article § 7-213(i)

(i) On or before December 1 each year, the Commission shall report its findings and recommendations on the Baltimore region transit systems to the Administration, the Governor, and, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly.
