METHOD

- MODE: Push to web (mail delivery with QR code) in June & July 2023
- **SAMPLE:** Representative sample of 1,352 adults 818 in Baltimore City 535 in Baltimore County

WEIGHTS: Sample & post-stratification weights to make results representative of Baltimore City & Baltimore County residents

OF ERROR: Uncertainty due to drawing a sample of the population: ± 4.2% ±5.1% among Baltimore City residents ±6.3% among Baltimore County residents
