# Why Self Certification?

- The Metropolitan Planning Rule directs all Transportation Management Areas (i.e., urbanized areas with a population of 200,000 or more) to certify that the metropolitan transportation planning process is being carried out by the State and the MPO in accordance with all applicable requirements
- Concurrent with the submittal of any proposed Transportation Improvement Program to the FHWA and the FTA

# What Are These Applicable Requirements?

1. Metropolitan Planning Regulations
2. Clean Air Act (Conformity Determination)
3. Nondiscrimination – General
4. Nondiscrimination – Civil Rights (Civil Rights Act of 1964)
5. Nondiscrimination – ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990)

# What Are These Applicable Requirements?

6. Nondiscrimination – Aging
7. Nondiscrimination – Gender
8. Nondiscrimination – Disabilities (Rehabilitation Act of 1973)
9. Involvement of Disadvantaged Business Enterprises
10. Equal Employment Opportunity

- Notes the updated Title VI Program and ADA Self-Assessment
