GOVERNOR'S FUNDING ANNOUNCEMENT

June 15, 2018

- Governor Larry Hogan Announced Additional \$890 Million for Northbound I-95 Express Toll Lanes (ETL)
 - Expanded \$1.1 Billion program will provide two ETLs for more than 10 miles from north of MD 43 in Baltimore County to north of MD 24 in Harford County.






I-95 ETL NORTHBOUND EXTENSION

- Two-Lane Northbound ETL Facility, MD 43 to MD 24
- Reconstruct Interchanges at MD 152 and MD 24
- Flyover Ramp at MD 24
- Reconstruct Overpasses: Raphel Road, Bradshaw Road, Old Joppa Road, Clayton Road




- Reconstruct Northbound Bridges: Big Gunpowder, Little Gunpowder, Winters Run


