## **FY 2024 UPWP**

**Resolution #23-19 highlights:** 

- UPWP activities are based on the Metropolitan Planning Regulations as well as Planning Factors identified in the FAST Act.
- The FY 2024 budget totals \$10,880,000
- BMC staff are supported with \$6,870,000
- Local jurisdiction activities are supported with \$480,000
- Consultant activities are supported with \$3,530,000
- A 2.5% set-aside from PL funds for Complete Streets types of activities.





## FY 2024 UPWP cont.

- Included a 30-day public review between February 8 to March 9.
- A number of comments was received. The comments and proposed responses are awaiting TC/BRTB approval. Responses will be sent out by the end of the week.
- After the FY 2023 close-out, a resolution in September 2023 will identify any carry-over and associated tasks to be added to the FY 2025 Addendum.
