The following is a brief update on the activities of the COG Cooperative Purchasing Program.

CURRENT BIDS & AWARDS

COG Led:

<u>Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA)</u> – multiple awards in place and is being used by several agencies in the COG region.

<u>Ice Melt</u> – one contract in place for basic ice melt.

<u>EMS Medical Supplies Bid</u> – in the final year of a three-year award that ends on April 30, 2020. Currently canvasing to see if there is interest in rebidding. Two vendors are currently under contract (BoundTree Medical and Henry Schein).

<u>Water and Wastewater Treatment Chemicals</u> – awards with several vendors in place with the Rider Clause.

<u>Health and Wellness Training</u> – awards in place with O2X and Inova for workplace health and wellness training.

<u>Temp Staffing Master Contracts</u> – COG has 12 master contracts in place for temporary staffing services including public safety, office, environmental and IT.

Search and Rescue Software - award pending BAFO.

<u>Master Contract for Public Safety Planning</u> – ridable master contracts with 10 consulting companies for public safety planning and training. This is a task order based contract.

Road salt - led by Montgomery County

Gasoline - led by Montgomery County

Diesel fuel - led by WMATA

P-Card services – led by Fairfax County

POSSIBLE SOLICIATIONS

Cardiac packs, defibrillators, and accessories projected for mid-2020.

Subscriber Radios due for rebid in fall of 2020.

Others being examined are fire rescue tools and equipment, IT services and consultants
